

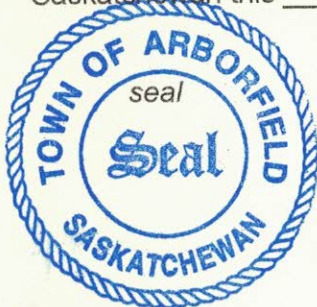
**A BYLAW OF THE TOWN OF ARBORFIELD IN THE PROVINCE OF SASKATCHEWAN TO AUTHORIZE THE COUNCIL TO REGULATE THE SUPPLY AND MANAGEMENT OF GARBAGE AND RECYCLING SERVICES.**

**WHEREAS** the Council may regulate the distribution of carts for garbage and recycling in the Municipality and may fix the rates of payment in accordance with Section 8(1)(i) of *The Municipalities Act*:

**NOW THEREFORE** the Council of the Town of Arborfield enacts as follows:

- 1) All households and businesses which are not vacant shall be supplied with a set of carts; one for garbage and one for recycling from the waste disposal service provider contracted by the Town.
- 2) The schedule for collection service for each type of waste shall be set by the waste disposal service provider under agreement with the Municipality.
- 3) Any household or business may opt out of having garbage and/or recycling collection service with the Town's service provider by making an application to the Administrator with proof that they are using another garbage and/or recycling collection service.
- 4) The Municipality shall pay the service provider on behalf of the household or business the monthly rental for each set of carts.
- 5) The Council may, at its discretion, refuse or remove garbage or recycling collection services at a household or business if it is considered that there has been a misuse, waste, or other valid reason to take such action with the stipulation that the household or business obtains the services of another garbage and/or recycling provider.
- 6) A **Recycle** fee of **\$16.00/month** per household account and a **Business Recycle** fee of **\$28.00/month** per business account shall be charged out to each household or business possessing a set of carts and the fees shall be billed quarterly with the utility billing notices.
- 7) A **Garbage** fee of **\$14.00/month** per household accounts and a **Business Garbage** fee of **\$27.00/month** per business account shall be charged out to each household or business possessing a set of carts and the fees shall be billed quarterly with the utility billing notices.
- 8) Any household or business may request a second set of carts by making an application to the Administrator. The fee for each subsequent set of carts shall be charged out at the rates set out above.
- 9) Bylaw No. 2023-003 is hereby repealed.


