

Becoming a candidate:

1. Determine if you are eligible a) Are you 18 years old? b) Are you a Canadian citizen? c) Have you resided in Saskatchewan for the past 6 months? d) Have you resided in the Town of Arborfield for the past three months? Yes to all questions means you are eligible.
2. Obtain a nomination form.
3. Fill out the appropriate sections with your name, occupation and address. Choose which office you wish to be a candidate for: Mayor or Councillor.
4. Obtain 5 signatures from eligible voters of the Town of Arborfield. Voters must be 18 years old, Canadian citizens, must have resided in Saskatchewan for the past 6 months and either reside or own property in the Town of Arborfield for the past three months.
5. Fill out your name and occupation (how you want it to appear on the ballot) in the Candidate's Acceptance section. Fill out the office you are accepting the nomination for: Mayor or Councillor.
6. Fill out one way to contact you. This is how you will be notified that you were acclaimed into the position or that an election will be held.
7. Date and sign the form in front of 2 witnesses, no requirement that these be voters.
8. Return the form to the Town office before 4 pm on **October 9, 2024 – Nomination Day**.
9. If you are not delivering the form in person – please make sure it is received by phoning the administrator to confirm – (306)769-0101.
10. An election will be called if there is more than one nomination received for the office of Mayor or if there are more than four nominations received for the office of Councillor.
